PROJECT UPDATE

Since our last update on the Greenwood Gardens QNP, the Public Works Department has completed painting the stop bars on the pavement at the three-way and the four-way stop signs that were requested with the adoption of the Quality Neighborhood Program.

As for the Maitland Boulevard off-ramp, the project is still scheduled to go out to bid in January of 2004, with construction to begin after permits have been approved.

There is some great news to report on the revitalization of the Downtown Master Plan. Approval of the CRA for the Master Plan includes funding for a buffer wall along the Westside of the railroad tracks from Greenwood Road to Sybelia Avenue. Details of the buffer have not been determined. As this improvement is not actually part of the QNP, there is no additional cost to the approved QNP assessment (item was removed earlier due to the cost). As more information concerning this project becomes available, you will be updated.
