



Household Garbage

Your garbage is collected twice a week.

Place trash in City provided 96 gallon containers. Overflow materials must be placed in 35 gallon containers or in heavy duty plastic trash bags secured properly to prevent the scattering of waste due to animals or wind.

All residential waste must be placed curbside within 3 feet of the edge of the traveled portion of the roadway.

Large Items / White Goods

Residents can call to schedule collection throughout the year for a minimum fee per item.

- Refrigerators /freezers
- Washers /dryers
- Air conditioning units
- Stoves /ranges
- Water heaters
- Furniture

Clean Up Weeks

Twice a year, during the first week of May and November, the City allows residents to place "Large Items/White Goods" out with their trash at no additional cost. ***This is not an amnesty week. Pick-up rules and limitations will still apply.***

Household Hazardous Waste is Not Accepted

By law, Hazardous Waste cannot be collected curbside. The materials described below, along with other household hazardous waste, can be disposed of by the resident at the following facilities free of charge:

What is Household Hazardous Waste?

It is defined as any product that includes any of the following words on its label: Flammable, Poison, Warning, Corrosive, Explosive, Danger, Pesticide, Caustic, or Acid. Latex or oil based paint, and items containing mercury, such as fluorescent lights and thermostats, are also considered hazardous waste.

- Wet paint: oil and water based aerosols, or stains.
- Pool chemicals: chlorine or acids.
- Petroleum Products: gasoline, oil, and diesel fuel.
- Rechargeable batteries: Ni-cad and Lithium.
- Cleaning products: strippers or cleaners,
- Pesticides: insect killers or rodent killers.
- Herbicides: weed killers.
- Fertilizers: liquid and granular.
- LP Gas bottles

Recycling

Residents are given two (2) recycling bins. **Items can be placed in either the Blue or Red Bins.**



Accepted materials are:

- Newspaper
- Flattened cardboard (i.e. cereal boxes with plastic taken out) (For pieces larger than bin, please flatten and tie in bundle not greater than 3' by 3')
- Mixed office paper / magazines

While we except mixed recycling, separating and rinsing your recyclables speeds the process and reduces the items that can't be used because they have been contaminated.

- Plastic containers #1 through #7 (#'s located bottom of container).
- Glass bottles
 - clear, green and brown
- Aluminum and steel cans

****Please do NOT include any recyclable item with food in or attached to it. This could cause contamination of your items. **Remember to rinse out all containers and discard lids, including water bottles caps.***



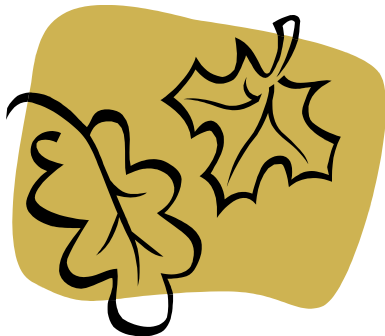


Yard Waste

Yard Waste is collected on Wednesday as follows:

- ❖ Grass clippings, leaves and other loose vegetative materials must be placed in containers. Appropriate containers include a City provided 96 gallon cart, or resident provided container(s) not larger than 35 gallons or sealed plastic bags holding less than 40 lbs.
- ❖ Branches must be tied and bundled.
- ❖ Limbs / branches should not exceed four (4) feet in length, six (6) inch radius or fifty (50) pounds.
- ❖ All residential yard waste must be placed curbside within 3 feet of the edge of the traveled portion of the roadway.

Items not included are: wood fencing, landscape timbers, flower pots, yard decorations, mulch, and dirt.



Holiday Schedule

The designated holidays that collection services are not provided are:

- ✚ New Year Day
- ✚ Memorial Day
- ✚ The Fourth of July
- ✚ Labor Day
- ✚ Thanksgiving Day
- ✚ Christmas Day

If your collection day falls on a holiday, your garbage, yard waste or recycling will be collected on your next regularly scheduled collection day. Because of the extra volume collected during these periods, extra trucks are added. All items must be out for collection by 7:00am to guarantee pick-up. Any items placed out after 7:00am and missed will be picked up on the next scheduled collection day.

Residential Services

- Garbage twice a week in 96 gallon cart.
- Curbside household recycling once a week with two bins provided.
- Yard waste once a week on Wednesday
