**360:** The number of books Clara Dommerich donated to the newly established Maitland Public Library in 1896.

**1900:** Outraged at the slaughter of birds for the millinery industry, concerned residents form the Florida Audubon Society.

**1907:** The Maitland Public Library moves to its permanent residence at 501 S. Maitland Avenue.

**1938:** J. Andre Smith forms the Research Studio.

**1954:** The Dommerich estate is sold to developers for \$420,000.

**1959:** The Town of Lake Maitland gets a new charter and drops "Lake" from its name.



## As Storm Season Approaches, It's Time to Prepare



As we all know here near the tropics, we occasionally receive unwanted visitors. No, not your long-lost cousin and his ten kids -- we're referring to hurricanes or tropical storms. The season officially runs from June 1 to November 30 every year.

### Exterior

It is very important to keep any potentially airborne items during a storm event inside your home or tied down. Items such as cans, lawn furniture, swing sets, or yard waste like tree branches should be secured. If you live in an apartment or condo, remove balcony furniture and other items.

You may want to have any large trees on your property inspected by a reputable tree service. Tree service employees are familiar with the signs of weakness in trees such as rotten or weak limbs. They also can prune the trees of any overgrowth in a tree canopy.

### Interior

If you are not sure if your garage door will stand up to hurricane force winds, you can add some stability to it by simply backing your car up tight against the door in an emergency. Similarly, door reinforcement kits are available for purchase.

The next most vulnerable openings in a house, apartment, or condo are the windows. Windows could be covered with hurricane shutters or you could use plywood.

Additionally, identify an interior area without a window within your home that could function as a shelter for you and your family.

Along with preparing your home for storms, you should remember to prepare your family or business through education and development of an emergency plan. Such a plan is very essential and should include procedures for personal or business disaster recovery. Remember to include any pets in your plan. # PUBLIC WORKS

## Pipeline

The Maitland Public Works Department continues its work for all Maitland residents. Here you will find a list of completed projects and projects in the pipeline.

### COMPLETED:

-  Replanted and re-mulched medians along U.S. 17-92
-  Repaired two emergency stormwater pipelines
-  Renovated and re-painted the gazebo at Lake Lily Park

### IN THE PIPELINE:

-  Kings Row Park Upgrades. Planned improvements include landscaping, walking paths, playground equipment, a water fountain, and parking spaces.
-  Downtown Storm Sewer Project. Engineering is proceeding for construction of a storm sewer in the downtown area, from Independence Lane to George Avenue.
-  Old Horatio Covered Bridge Roof Replacement. It is anticipated that construction will be completed by the end of summer.
-  Maitland Community Park Water Transmission Upgrade. Plans are being prepared for construction of a new water transmission main from Mayo Avenue to Arapaho Trail.
-  Lift Station #4 Diversion Project. The project to construct a sanitary sewer force main under Horatio Avenue for increased capacity is out for bid. The work will be performed in a way to minimize disruption on this crucial east-west thoroughfare.

### Parks Master Plan Update: Participate in a Survey

The City is updating the Parks & Recreation Master Plan. The Master Plan provides a comprehensive plan for the future of Maitland's parks, facilities and recreation programming.

The City held a series of six focus groups in April, and the next step is a community-wide survey. In May, a statistically valid survey will be mailed directly to 3,000 City residents, and a companion online survey will be available to all interested stakeholders on the City's website. ### Maitland Receives Tree City USA Designation for Fifth Year in a Row



The Tree City USA designation, awarded by the Arbor Day Foundation, provides

municipalities a framework for community forestry management. To qualify for the designation, a community must have a department overseeing its tree management program, an annual budget supporting the program, a tree ordinance, and an Arbor Day observance. The City has met all four requirements for five years in a row.
