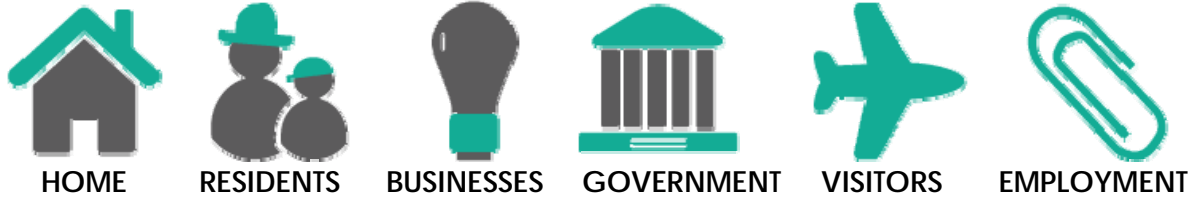

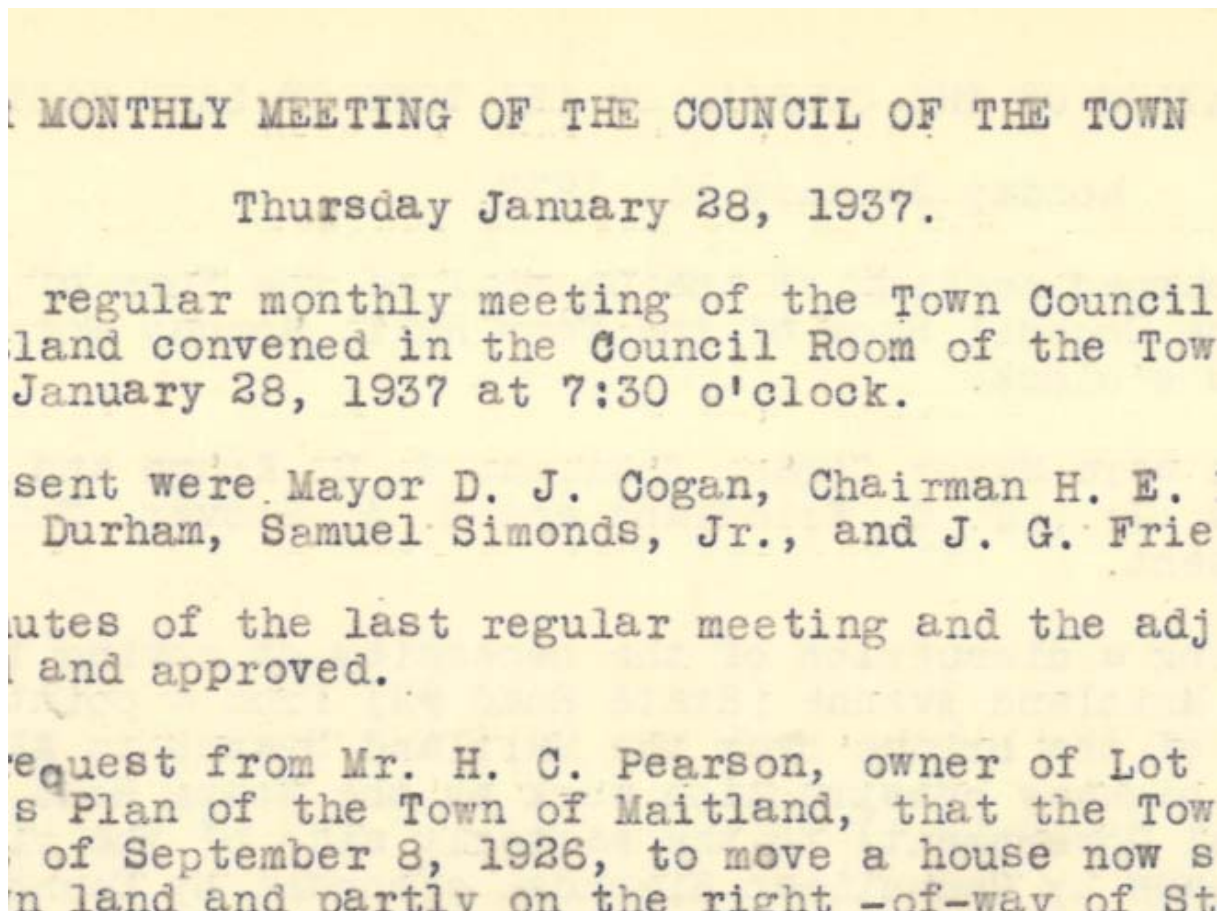

...Two New Portals to Access City Records:



The City has two new portals for access of current and historical documents.

The first portal is a library of City Council meeting minutes going back to 1924, ordinances going back to the year 2000, and resolutions going back to the year 2000. Keyword search is available. <http://documents.itsmymaitland.com>

The second portal is a compendium for agendas, agenda backup, and minutes going back decades. The agenda itself is a dynamic page full of links to greensheets, minutes, documents, and exhibits. Agenda items are linked to the corresponding greensheet or document. Before this new portal, a person would have to download the entire agenda backup packet (which could be a couple hundred pages), and scroll through the document to find the greensheet or document of interest. 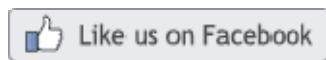
The Week Ahead
