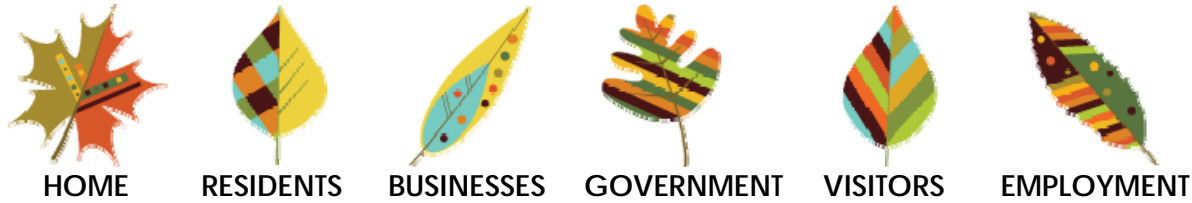

Art Under the Stars

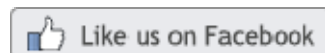
The Rotary Club of Maitland will host the 40th Art Under the Stars Festival at Lake Lily Park from November 11 - 13, 2016.
