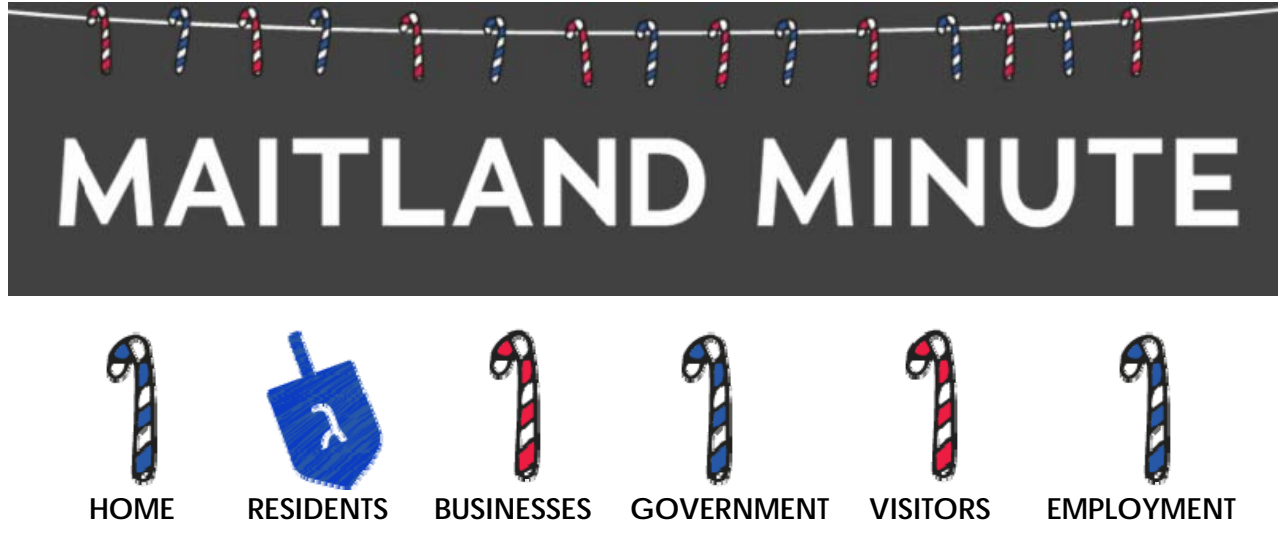

New Maitland Express is Ready for Viewing

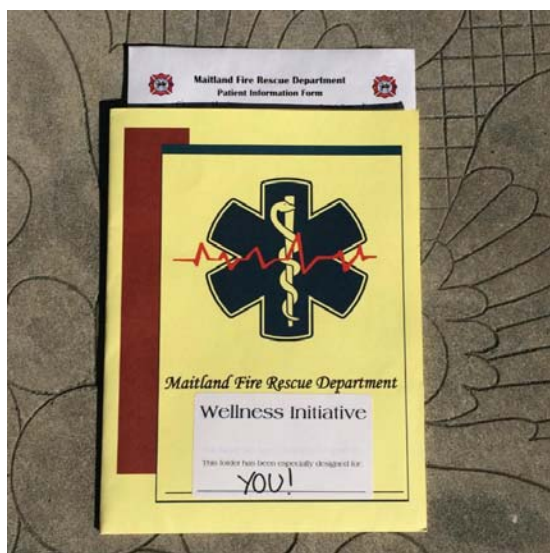
Building Downtown MAITLAND in 2016

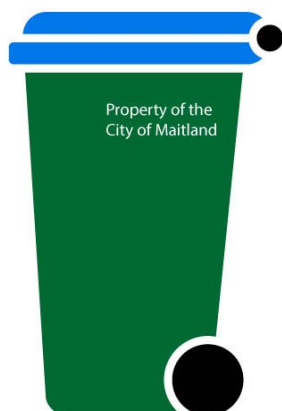

City Update

Bring in Garbage & Recycling Carts from the Curb on Non-Collection Days

The City has received complaints about garbage and recycling carts placed on the curb for collection before - and lingering after - the allowable time. From the City Code:



Chapter 7 - HEALTH AND SANITATION
ARTICLE II. - GARBAGE AND TRASH
Sec. 7-29. - Time for placing, removal of containers.

All garbage and recycling carts shall be placed in the manner provided in this article no earlier than 5:00 p.m. of the day preceding the day designated for collection and shall be removed not later than 7:00 p.m. on such designated day. Dumpsters and roll-off containers may remain in their permanent location.
