

Uniform Patrol (including Marine and Fleet), crash investigations, arrests, traffic enforcement, and 24/7 are under the command of Police. In FY 2016, Operations investigated approximately 1,100 vehicular crashes.

Police Support Services
Police Support Services empowers local criminal investigations, training, crime prevention, records as well as juvenile delinquency, and other services. Detectors spent approximately 1,100 hours investigating crimes in FY 2016.



With Great Lakes Come Great Responsibility

The Lakes Management Division and the Lakes Advisory Board are working hard to reduce the amount of chemicals and fertilizers entering Maitland's lakes and waterways. Each week on [Facebook](#), [Twitter](#), and [Nextdoor](#), we will provide Maitland residents with a tip to improve their lawns while also protecting the quality of the lakes. *You don't have to be a homeowner with property on a lake to observe fertilizer rules and best practices. Every Maitland resident can do their part to improve water quality in Maitland.*

The Water Quality Tip of the Week: Fertilize in the dry season (October - May). Many fertilizers are 50 percent slow release. This means that your lawn slowly absorbs the fertilizer over time. The summer rains can wash away the fertilizer and the fertilizer flows into Maitland's lakes via the storm drains. So, the money you invested in fertilizing your lawn during the rainy season drains your wallet, pollutes the lakes, and doesn't help your lawn.
