It's My Maitland: Our Downtown is Underway!

[The January 15 edition of Maitland Minute](#) included a downtown Maitland traffic advisory. One of the projects listed in the advisory, "Downtown Utilities," will come to pass very soon, resulting in a temporary lane closure of a crucial east-west thoroughfare in Maitland for a number of weeks in February.

We thank you in advance for your patience:

Eastbound Horatio Avenue between Maitland Avenue and U.S. 17-92 closed today for approximately two weeks. Crews will install underground sewer and stormwater facilities during this timeframe. The intersection of Independence Lane and Horatio Avenue will be closed to traffic.



Independence Lane from the City Hall Parking Lot to Packwood Avenue will remain open but there will be changes to travel patterns. These changes include shifting traffic to the western portion of Independence Lane to the on-street parking stalls to maintain two-way traffic.

Maintenance of traffic will be in place.

Westbound Horatio Avenue between Maitland Avenue and U.S. 17-92 will remain open to motorists traveling to points west.

FDOT has tentatively rescheduled the temporary closure of southbound U.S. 17-92 under the railroad trestle. The dates of the closure, subject to weather conditions, include Thursday, February 4, through Monday, February 8, **and** Friday, February 12, through Monday, February 15. City Business

The City Council considered a number of agenda items on January 25, including a public hearing of Ordinance - Petition No. 2015-14 (AZ) (PD) 511 Maitland Boulevard (Maitland Concourse North) - Option 1. No vote was taken and it will appear again on the February 8 City Council agenda.

The City Council also authorized the City Manager to sign revised contracts with IMMO Maitland, LLC, and RUELJO, LLC, to purchase the necessary rights-of-way to extend Independence Lane from Horatio Avenue to George Avenue, subject to approval of the property-exchange agreement.
