City Business



The City Council approved a pilot project agreement with Uber and an interlocal agreement establishing the Municipal Mobility Working Group, comprising of Maitland, Altamonte Springs, Lake Mary, Longwood, and Sanford.

Beginning on July 1, the City will pay 20 percent off fares for Uber trips that begin and end within Maitland proper. Similarly, the City will pay 25 percent off fares for Uber trips taken to and from the Maitland SunRail Station. The subsidy cap is \$5 and \$6.25, respectively. More information will follow.
