The City of Maitland Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) is continuing the process of updating the Downtown Master Plan.

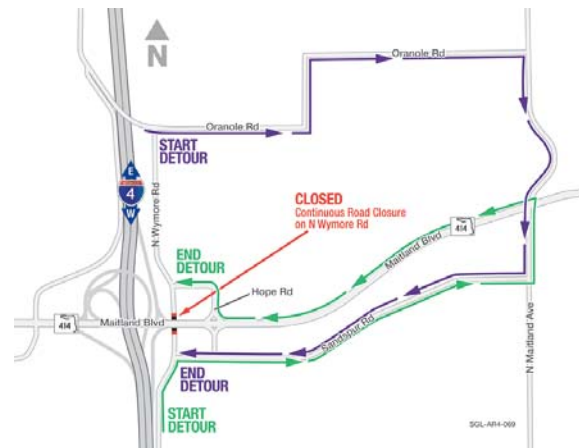
The CRA will host a public meeting at the Maitland Civic Center on Wednesday, June 22, 2016, beginning at 6:30 p.m.
