Coming Soon - Lift Station No. 4 Diversion Project



This project entails construction of over 9,500 feet of sewer force main throughout the eastern service area of the City. The pipeline will start on Old Horatio Avenue, and will proceed easterly to Dommerich Drive, Algonquin Trail, Arapaho Trail, and Mohican Trail, ending near Thistle Lane. The majority of the construction will be performed using a technique known as directional drilling to minimize the amount of roadway excavation and to reduce the impacts to

our citizens.

- *Construction is expected to begin in the middle of this summer.
