ABOUT & STATUS: Hurricane Matthew made landfall on Haiti earlier today. The projected path includes the U.S. East Coast. As of October 4, 2016, the Maitland Fire-Rescue Department is currently monitoring the hurricane. The National Hurricane Center stated at 5:00 p.m. that the "northern eyewall of extremely dangerous Hurricane Matthew [is] already pounding the eastern tip of Cuba."

SANDBAGS: The City will provide sand, bags, and shovels for residents to bag sand. The area for sandbag assembly will be at the North City Hall parking lot north of Horatio Avenue, between Maitland Avenue & U.S. 17-92. Dates and times: Wednesday (10/5) - 9 a.m. - 5 p.m. & Thursday (10/6) - 9 a.m. - 1 p.m. (weather permitting). Limit eight bags per resident. Proof of residency is required. The Maitland Fire-Rescue Department is pushing out a notification about the sandbags for residents with landlines. Unfortunately, the notification system does not work for cell phones.

PREPARE: Take the time to prepare by putting away or securing outdoor items and reviewing preparedness plans. Social media users, please use the hashtag #MatthewMaitland. Call 3-1-1 for hurricane information. Call 9-1-1 for all emergencies. Check out the attached resources for more information about EOC and preparedness. A checklist also is included.

TRASH/RECYCLING: The decision to suspend trash and recycling service will be made on Wednesday, Oct. 5.
