## Maitland SunRail Station Bell-Ringing Ceremony

MAITLAND, Fla. (April 28, 2014) – The City of Maitland, in partnership with the Florida Department of Transportation, is hosting a station bell-ringing ceremony as part of the system-wide SunRail Whistlestop Tour at 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, April 30, 2014.

A train carrying dignitaries from the Florida Department of Transportation as well as the cities of Altamonte Springs, DeBary, Lake Mary, Longwood, and Sanford will arrive in Maitland at 9:57 a.m. Upon arrival at 9:57 a.m., Mayor Schieferdecker and Mayor Jacobs will greet Secretary Prasad and Secretary Downs during a brief seven-minute program. Dignitaries will board the train following the program.

The ceremony is part of an 11-station event tour through municipalities along the SunRail corridor, which culminates in a grand-opening celebration at the Sand Lake Road terminus at 11:00 a.m.

SunRail opens its doors to the public on Thursday, May 1, 2014, and will provide free weekday rides for passengers from May 1, 2014, through May 16, 2014. SunRail only will operate during the weekdays.
