## Maitland SunRail Station Grand Opening Event

MAITLAND, Fla. (April 7, 2014) – The City of Maitland, in partnership with the Florida Department of Transportation, is hosting a grand opening and ribbon-cutting ceremony to introduce Maitland’s new SunRail station at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

Following the program, attendees will tour the SunRail train, station, and ticket kiosks as part of an overall effort by the Florida Department of Transportation to introduce potential riders to the new service which begins on May 1st.

Each train is to be equipped with wireless internet connectivity, luggage and bicycle storage, and restroom facilities. The Maitland SunRail station features four ticket kiosks, six ticket validators, and 125 on-site parking spaces. SunRail staff will be present to answer questions from the public.

Grand opening event parking will only be available at the Maitland City Hall on 1776 Independence Avenue, Maitland, Fla. Shuttles will transport attendees from off-site parking to the station. The first shuttle departs Maitland City Hall for the SunRail station at 1:15 p.m.
