In April, the Leisure Services Department began the process of updating its Parks and Recreation Master Plan. As part of the process, the City of Maitland contracted with GreenPlay, LLC to inventory and assess the City's existing facilities and program offerings to

determine how they can be updated, expanded, and improved to meet the community's current and future needs.

On Wednesday, November 4 at 7:00 p.m., the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board (PRAB) will host a public meeting to share GreenPlay's findings of and gather additional data. All area residents are invited to attend this session and offer their input. The meeting takes place at the City Council Chambers at 1776 Independence Lane.
