Greetings to you!

There are two exciting items to report on the Neighborhood Program this quarter. The City has sent out easement forms for forty-seven properties in the Ridgewood area. This is the first step toward relocating all utilities underground (electrical power lines and cable) and installing pedestrian streetlights. Easements are required for certain property corners to locate transformers. The transformers are approximately three (3) feet wide by three (3) feet long and thirty (30) inches high. When all the easements have been completed and returned to the City, Progress Energy will schedule the construction for the undergrounding.



The picture above shows the construction fencing along the proposed expansion of the Park Maitland School. The first phase of the project includes a permanent turnaround on Tangerine Place with a decorative wall and landscaping. The proposed wall

is similar to the one constructed along Orlando Avenue (pictured here on the left) except the landscaping will be at ground level.
